## Things to Know

Tucson was founded in 1775, with a population of over half a million people. There is something for everyone to enjoy in this town and the climate allows you to enjoy outdoor activities year-round. Summers can get extremely warm but spring, fall and winter are fairly mild. Tucson is surrounded by five mountain ranges in the Sonoran Desert, is 100 miles south of the state capital (Phoenix), and 60 miles north of the U.S.-Mexico border. Tucson's elevation is 2,389 ft.

**Driving** – Must be 15 years and 7 months to obtain your driving permit. Driver's education is not a requirement for your license; however you must have had your permit a minimum of six months.
