## JANUARY IN HISTORY

**17 January 1966:** A nuclear equipped B-52 bomber flying an Operation "Chrome Dome" alert mission off the coast of Spain collided with a KC-135 "Stratotanker" during refueling, destroying both planes. Four B28 thermonuclear weapons fell from the sky, three landing near the village of Palomares and one sinking into the Mediterranean Sea. It was one of the worst nuclear disasters in US military history.



Two of the weapon's conventional charges went off upon impact, spreading contamination; one landed largely intact, while the fourth sank 2,850 feet below the surface in the sea.

The USS Hoist was dispatched to find the US Air Force bomb. Navy Master Diver Carl Brashear, the Navy's first black diver lost his leg in the recovery operation, but later returned to duty despite the amputation. He consequently received the Navy and Marine Corps Medal, the highest Navy award for non-combat heroism. You can see the story by watching the 2000 movie, *Men of Honor*.

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
