

Pets:

- Limit 3 dogs per site/RV.
 - Pets must be on a leash at all times when walking them on base. The leash must be connected to the pet and held by the owner at all times.
 - Do not leave pets tied up/caged/fenced outside your unit, unattended.
 - Please pick up all pet droppings immediately. Bags and trash receptacles are provided in the dog walk/dog park areas.
- Dispose of pet droppings only in designated receptacles.
- Please ensure pets are not a nuisance or disturb other guests. Disturbances include, but are not limited to, constant barking, howling, running loose, etc.
 - Pets are not allowed in any FamCamp facility (office, restroom, laundry, etc). Service animals are exempt from this policy. However, service animals are NOT exempt from the leash policy.
 - For your convenience and pleasure, there is a doggie park located in the Phantom Court area. The doggie park is an off-leash area where you can run and play with your dog. Please follow the posted rules.
 - Do not bathe pets in any of our facilities. For all your pet washing needs, please visit our pet wash station, located next to the horseshoe restrooms (building 6012).
 - If you see someone not in compliance with these rules, please report it to the office. Do not involve yourself/ confront the offender.
 - Failure to comply with these rules will result in you being required to remove your pet from the FamCamp.

Privately Owned Firearms:

- **All firearms must be registered**, using an AF Form 1314, with the Security Forces Armory in Bldg 1358. The guest and all members of their party age 18 or older must also complete a DD Form 2760. These forms are provided at the FamCamp office and must be signed by the FamCamp manager. **It is your responsibility to ensure your firearms are properly registered.**

Emergencies: please call (520) 228-3333

- There are no emergency medical facilities on D-M AFB. In case of an emergency please call (520) 228-3333. This number will go directly to the base Fire Department Emergency Services.
- A listing of local medical facilities is available at the office.

Additional Park Rules:

The following rules will be enforced at D-M—FamCamp:

- The maximum **speed limit is 5 miles per hour** throughout the park.
- Please observe all **one-way traffic signs**.
- **Quiet hours are from 2200 to 0600.** Please refrain from running generators during these hours. Only in extreme weather conditions, generators can run to keep guests comfortable. If you depart during quiet hours please attempt to keep noise to a minimum.
- All facilities are smoke free. This includes restrooms, laundry room, office area, dog park and other structures. Do not smoke near building entrances. Please dispose of cigarette butts in containers provided.
- If you have trees or bushes that conflict with your RV, please request assistance from the staff. Digging holes or trimming plants/trees will be taken care of by the maintenance crew.
- Place trash in dumpsters located throughout the park.
- **Guests are encouraged to recycle. The Base Recycling Center is located at the northwest corner of Wilmot Road & Yuma Street.**
- Water pressure fluctuates: Please use a water pressure regulator on your RV. The item on the bib is an anti-siphon device, not a pressure regulator. Occasional cloudy water is due to air in the system. It does not affect water quality.
- Sewer hook up: Sewer connection must be made using a sewer ring, commonly known as a “donut”, or similar device capable of blocking sewer gasses. This device can be purchased at a RV supply store or many local stores.
- Please refrain from doing any maintenance on RV or vehicles in the park. This includes, but is not limited to, changing oil, filters, wires/plugs, etc.
- Bird feeding: Due to the often unpleasant results that occur from the feeding of birds (droppings or damage to RVs, cars, etc.); bird feeding is limited to placement of hummingbird feeders.
- Please *do not* feed stray or wild animals that wander through the park. Although cute and sometimes friendly, these animals can be dangerous and aggressive.
- Maintain a clean and neat site.
- Please *do not* disturb other guests.
- When dealing with FamCamp staff and other guests please refrain from using profanity, threatening gestures, violence, etc.
- Guests are responsible for ensuring the safety and proper conduct of their dependents, sponsored guests, and themselves while staying at D-M FamCamp.
- Talking on cell phones while driving on D-M AFB is *prohibited* unless a hands free device is used.
- Helmets *are* required when riding bicycles on D-M AFB.
- Helmets *are* required when riding a motorcycle on base.
- Washing of RVs/vehicles is prohibited in the park. A do-it-yourself RV wash is located at the Auto Hobby Center.
- No parking is allowed on FamCamp streets. Park in your site or at a designated parking area.

Guests may be evicted from the park at the manager’s discretion.

• Closed on Federal Holidays May-October, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

Accommodations:

- All full hook-up sites are equipped with water, sewer & 20/30/50 amp electric.
- Handicap sites are available upon request. Handicap placard or license plate is required to utilize these spaces.
- Tent camping is allowed in Phantom Court.
- **Overflow guests have access to all facilities in the park.**
- **Reservations are not taken for ANY site.**
- **Spaces are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.**

Acceptable Camping Vehicles:

- Class A, B, and C motor homes, motor home conversions with proper RV style connections (van or bus), travel trailer, fifth-wheel trailer, trucks with slide-in campers and pop-up trailers are acceptable.
- All vehicles using the FamCamp must maintain their mechanical ability to be moved and be current on all registration and insurance.

Fees:

For military ID cards holders/DoD civilians:

- Full hook-up (per night) \$22.00
- Overflow (dry/tent camp, per night) \$11.00

For all others (non-ID card holders):

- Full hook-up (per night) \$27.00
- Overflow (dry/tent camp, per night) \$17.00

Five (5) Month Extended Stay:

- **Extended Stay** may be purchased between 1 Oct and 30 Apr each year. Guests Extended Stay will *not* have to rotate into overflow when the park becomes full.

Cost is \$3,473.00, paid upon registration (**non-refundable**).

- Guests cannot have more than 21 days in the park prior to beginning their 5 month stay.

Extended Stay guest, has an option to extend for additional month at a cost of \$690.00

- After 5 months or the conclusion of no more than 183 days, guests must leave the base, with all their belongings, for a minimum of 24 hours.

Three (3) Month (90 day) Extended Stay:

- **Extended Stay** may be purchased between 1 Oct and 30 Apr each year. Guests **Extended Stay** will **not** have to rotate into overflow when the park becomes full.

• Cost is \$2,070.00, paid upon registration (**non-refundable**).

• Guests can have no more than 90 days in the park prior to beginning their 3 month stay. *Extended Stay guest, has an option to extend for additional month at a cost of \$690.00*

- Guests may renew their 3 month contract, providing they do not exceed the maximum allowable days in the park (183).

Summer Rates:

- Starting 01 June - 31 August, military ID card holders/DoD civilians who pay for 6 days will get a 7th day, free!

Discounts:

- We honor the Air Force “Frequent Camper” program.

Refunds:

- With the exception of a verifiable death in the family, refunds for early departure are not given.

Renewal:

- Guests must come into the office NLT 1500, **the day before they are due out**, to see if renewal is possible.

Check-Out Time:

- **10:00 AM**

- In the event of a mechanical delay or emergency, please notify the office as soon as possible.

Registration:

- Guests wishing to register must have their RV/vehicle with them. After the registration process guests will be given a placard to be placed in the front window of the RV, showing proof of registration and assigned site.
- **Guests may have one RV and two other vehicles per site (a trailer is considered one vehicle). Please park vehicles in your site or a designated parking area, only.**
- Storage for additional vehicles may be arranged through the FamCamp Office.
- If you have visitors, please have them park in designated areas, such as at the bathhouses.

Length of Occupancy:

- Guests may register for 21 days at a time.
- At the conclusion of 183 consecutive days (6 months), guests must leave the base, with all their belongings, for a minimum of 24 hours.

Active Duty:

- Active duty personnel and their families have priority for occupancy.

Switching Sites:

- Any request to change assigned space must be approved by the FamCamp office. Approval and registration forms must be completed before the site change takes place.

Site changes are normally NOT allowed between 15 Dec and 31 Mar.

Dry-camping sites:

- Dry-camping sites are for Overflow use and are unavailable from May 1 to September 30.

Peak Season Overflow:

- Overflow is designated to provide a place for guests to dry camp while waiting for an opening in a full hook-up site during our peak season.
- When peak season overflow/rotation operations are in effect, **overflow guests will be placed on a waiting list on a first-come, first-served basis.** The quantity of available sites will be posted on the bulletin board, by the front door of the registration office by 1730 each business day.
- This list will only identify the number of sites that are available to be moved into the next day. NOT the site location number
- **During overflow/rotation operations the 21-day limit in the FamCamp is strictly enforced.**
- Full hook-up sites are checked at 1000 each morning to confirm availability.

Overflow Not Rotating:

- If a guest desires to remain in overflow (October-April) and not rotate into the main park, they may do so.

Sponsoring Guests:

- Non-military guests may be sponsored into FamCamp.
- **Sponsor must be present at time of registration.** Sponsors are not required to remain in the park with their guests; however; the sponsor will be responsible for the conduct of their guests. **There is no guarantee that sponsor and guest will be able to park near each other if they choose to stay in the park together.**

Laundry Facility:

- The laundry facility, located in building 6013 & 6020, are open 24/7 for your convenience. User assumes all risks of use. These facilities are for FamCamp guests only. A change machine for \$1, \$5, \$10 and \$20 bills is provided in each facility. Please remove clothing in a timely manner.
- **Washing or drying of pet bedding, rugs, pillows, blankets and greasy rags is NOT allowed.** Staff can direct you to Laundromats off base that can accommodate your needs.
- Hanging laundry or bath towels outside your RV is not permitted.

Campfires:

- As per the base fire marshal, wood campfires are only allowed at the designated fire pits. There is a fire pit in Eagle Court and a fire pit near the horseshoe restroom (building 6012). Wood campfires are NOT allowed in individual sites. You may cook with propane or charcoal only at your site.
